

### **GIFT AID DONATIONS**

If you are a UK tax payer you can boost your donation by 25p for each £1 you donate.

Gift Aid is reclaimed by the charity from the tax you pay for the current tax year. Your home address is needed to identify you as a current UK taxpayer.



# **DECLARATION** (TICK BOX TO CONFIRM)
